Department of English Language & Literature

The Department aims for students to develop their practical knowledge of English and an understanding of the cultures of the English-speaking world. In practical English programs, we not only educate students to communicate in English fluently, but also deepen their knowledge with a range of research and analysis on international affairs. Courses are mainly composed of English Grammar, English Communication, Practical English, Short Stories in English, British & American Culture, Business English and Current Events in English.

Social Welfare

Social work is unique among the helping professions because its clients are often those who are oppressed and alienated by society. Social workers are committed to improving not only the condition of individuals but also the society in which they live. Social workers must strive to move society toward the realization of its highest aspirations while also working with children, the young, women, the elderly, and the disabled, who are experiencing crisis and pain derived from existing social structures or personal circumstances.

Main Courses:

Introduction to Social Welfare, Social Welfare Administration, History of Social Welfare, Social Work for the Elderly, Social Work for the Disabled, Case Management, Social Welfare and Cultural Diversity, Introduction to Education Welfare, Youth Welfare and more.

Music

Faculty of Music is to produce professional musicians and creative experts. The educational goal is to train musicians by opening majors such as instrumental music, church music, and practical music, especially with dedicated, excellent curriculum which represents harmony between theory and practice provoking spirituality, intelligence, and emotion. In order to be able to do so, students will be trained to actively engaged in musical activities through our planning of various performances, seminars, master classes, solo recitals, and ensemble concerts.

Theology

Faculty of Theology educates students on an academic and practical level to serve the church and society on the basis of the protestant Christian reformed theology. It teaches theology and related subjects to train spiritual leaders to be faithfully and spiritually equipped for church and society.

Main Courses:

Systematic Theology : Manual of Christian Doctrine, The Reformed Theology, Learning and The Bible, Christian World-view, Heresy and Religion and more.

Old Testament Theology : The Old Testament Hebrew I & II, Introduction of the Old Testament, Pentateuch, Prophets, Historical Books, Poetical Books, The Old Testament Exegesis and more.

New Testament Theology : The New Testament Greek I & II, Introduction of the New Testament, The Four Gospels, Biblical Hermeneutics and more.

Historical Theology : History of Early Church, History of Christianity in the Middle Ages, History of Modern Church, History of Christianity in Korea and more.

Practical Theology : Introduction of Practical Theology, Missiology, Practical Ethics, Preaching and Writing Christian Education, Christian Counseling, Church Ministry and more.

English Language & Literature

The educational purpose of this department is to generate competent individuals who will be equipped with professional knowledge of English, and therefore, can positively contribute to the relationship between Korea and the world in the era of globalization. The educational courses focus on critical reading of literary and cultural texts, the study of prominent authors and genres, issues and questions pertaining to theoretical critiques and methodologies, and the relationship of literary works to their cultural, historical contexts and to other humanity disciplines.

Studies in 19th Century British Novels, Modern British-American Drama, Studies in 19th Century British and American Poetry, Seminars on British and American Drama, Shakespeare and Culture, Literary Criticism.

Social Welfare

Social work education in the Graduate School of Daeshin University is a very broadly conceived professional course, which is designed to provide understanding of the relationships and interactions among individuals, families, groups, and prepares students for professional counselling intervention on all levels.

Seminar in Social Welfare Policy, Seminar in Law and Practice on Social Welfare, Seminar of Social Problems, Seminar in Skills and Techniques for Social Work Practice, Seminar in Family Counseling and Therapy, Seminar in Social Work for the Disabled / Elderly and more.

Theology (M.Div and Th.M)

The graduate course of the Theology Department offers three streams of educational experience. Our professional degree program, the Master of Divinity, is designed with specializations for individuals who aim to apply what they learn in the classroom to their life in vocational ministry. The research degree programs, the Doctor of Philosophy (Christian Theology) and Master of Theology (Christian Studies), prepare individuals who feel called to academic teaching and writing ministries of the Church. A completed undergraduate course is required to enter the Master of Divinity, and a completed Master of Theology degree is required to enter the Doctor of Philosophy degree.

IEEI Introduction

International Exchange and Education Institute(IEEI) is a specialized educational institution of Korean language and culture. It was established on December, 2017 with the goal of introducing the Korean language and culture to the world.

IEEI is responsible for the following areas: Recruiting international students for Korean Language Course, undergraduate and graduate school and establishing academic agreements with other universities across the globe.

Korean Language Course is designed for foreigners who want to apply for undergraduate or graduate school in Korea. It consists of two parts; a course study of Korean textbooks and practical activities with various cultural experiences, which are desirable for foreign students to adjust to the Korean life-style along with learning Standard Korean.

The Korean language course is run for four semesters per year; 10 weeks per semester and five days per week. The course offers not only TOPIK lectures but also Korean cultural experience; old and new, and learning how to adapt to society.


